'Workshops' are a very important part of the festival.

Many young people don't have the possibility to learn about music, theatre and dance because private lessons are very expensive. But workshops are a great way for them to discover the things they like and what they are good at. And perhaps their future is to be singers, dancers or actors at this amazing festival.




