- Is Dex happy?
- Where's Dex's crayon?





Story frame 4

Dex: Oh no! Where's my yellow **crayon**?

Charlie & Meg: Here it is.

Dex: Oops, Sorry! This is my yellow crayon. My yellow crayon. Yippee!

Charlie & Meg: Oh, Dex!

- Has Dex got a crayon now?
- Is Dex happy now?
