Charlie: No, I don't. Nike blocks.


Meg: Oh OK! Do you like balls?

Dex: No, I don't. I like cars.


Meg: Oh OK! Do you like scooters?


**Dex:** Yes, I do! Tike cars and I like scooters!

- What does Dex like?






Meg: I like scooters. Whee!

Dex: Whoah!


Meg & Charlie: Oh no!

Meg: Sorry, Charlie. Let's play together!


**Dex:** Yes, let's play together!
