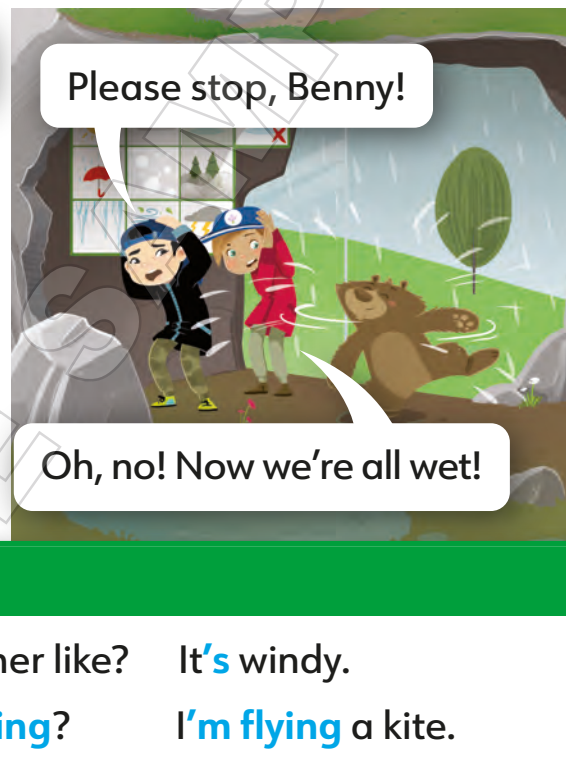

- 1 Sam, Lily and Benny are at the weather cave. They're learning about the weather.



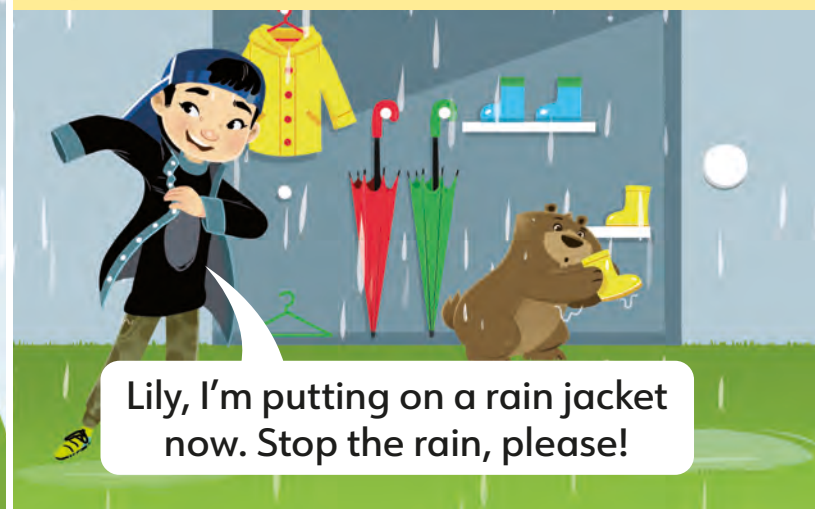
- 2 It's rainy and wet in the cave. Sam is shouting to Lily, but she's with her friend.
