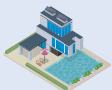

Is there a table in the kitchen?

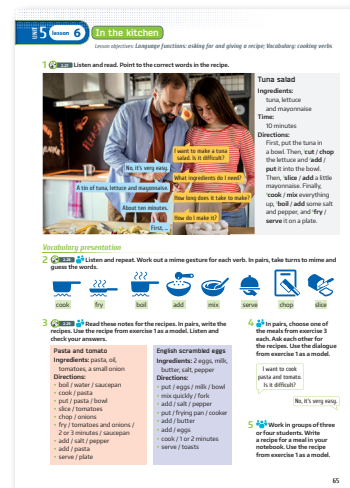
Yes, there is, and there are four chairs.
