

Grace: It's Toby's first day of school, but where's Toby?

He isn't in the classroom.

Jack: Look! He's in the library.

Grace: Hi, Toby!

Toby: Hi, Grace! Hi, Jack! I love books.

Daisy: Me too! I've got a book in the rucksack.

It's called The school for dragons.

- Where's Toby? (He's in the library.)
- What has Daisy got in her rucksack? (a book)
- Who says 'I love books'? (Toby)



Toby: Wow! We're in the school for dragons! And here's Sam!

Sam: Hello!

Grace: Hello, Sam. Look! It's the dragon from the book!

• Where are the children? (in the school for dragons)





Drake the Dragon: Hello. I'm Drake. I can't find my classroom.

Daisy: Don't be sad.

Jack: Let's help Drake.

- What's the dragon's name? (Drake)
- Is the dragon happy? (No, he's sad.)
- Who wants to help Drake? (Jack)



Sam: Yes, let's help Drake.

Librarian: Shh! Don't shout in the library.

Toby: Come on, everyone. Let's go.

- Where are the children? (in the library)
- Who says 'Let's help Drake'? (Sam)



Grace: Wait! Where's Sam?

Toby: He isn't in the corridor.

Daisy: And where's Drake?

- Where are the children? (in the corridor)
- Is Sam in the corridor? (no)



Grace: Look! Drake's in the gym.

Daisy: Sam's in the gym, too.

Sam: Come and play football.

Jack: It's time for class.

- Where are Drake and Sam? (in the gym)
- Who says 'It's time for class'? (Jack)



Doris: Hello, I'm Doris. Welcome to our school, Drake.

Let's go to the classroom.

Drake: OK. Thank you, Doris. Bye Sam,

Sam: Goodbye!
