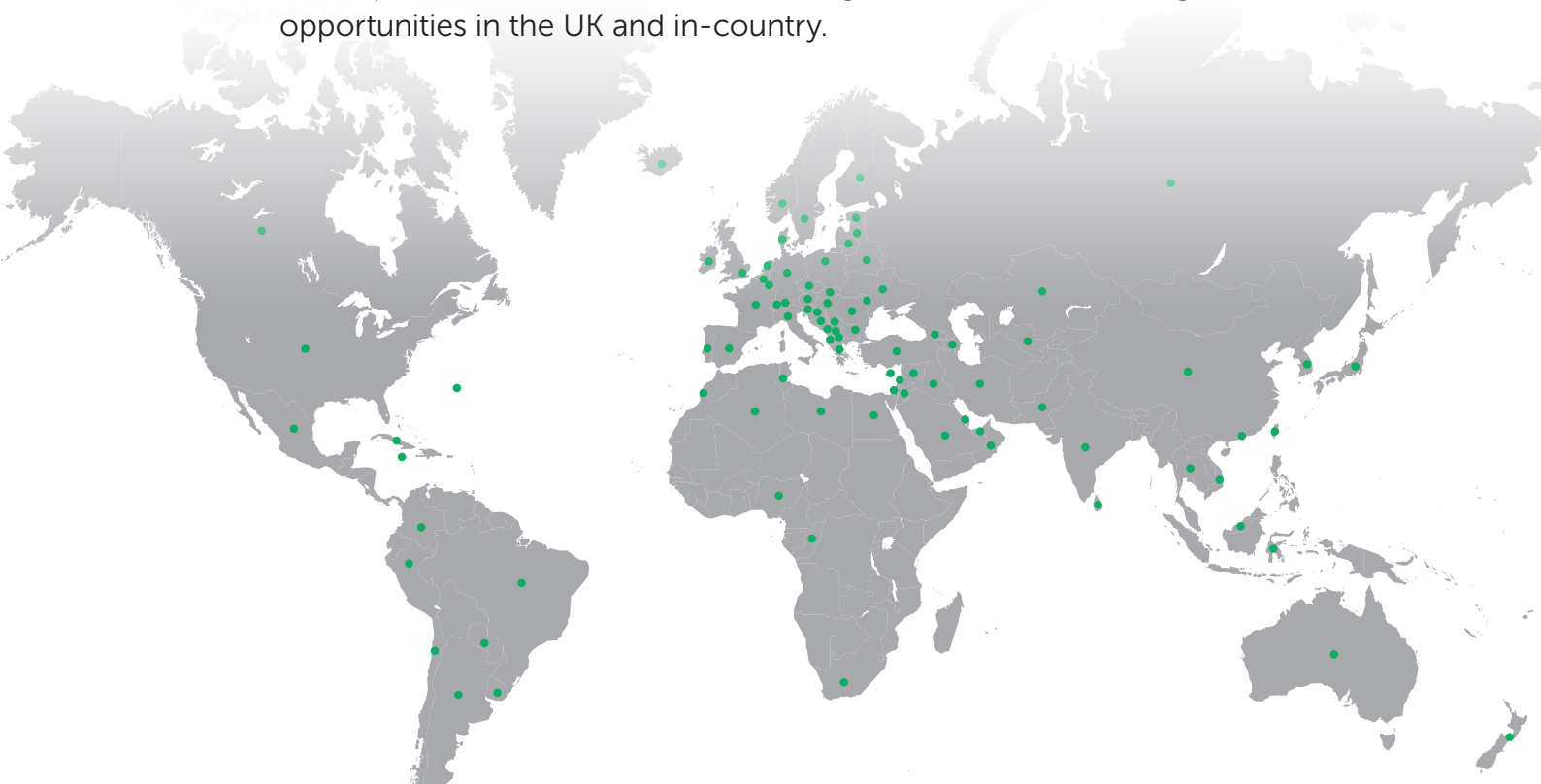

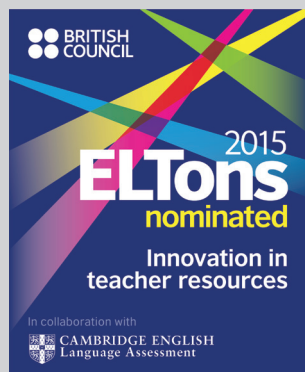

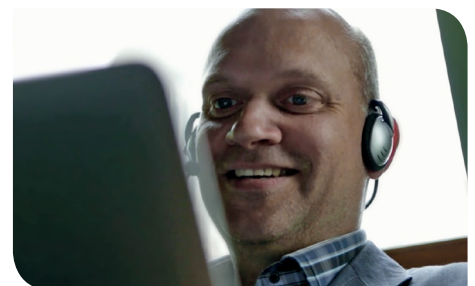

Yueyang,
China

Cascade training project

-  Course length: two years
-  Participants: 60 teachers
-  Location: in-country training in China and the UK

This two-year project began with a week-long in-country needs analysis which involved observations and focus groups across a range of secondary schools in Yueyang, China.




NILE developed a comprehensive course outline based on the participants' needs, to target areas including language improvement, cultural awareness, and communicative teaching practice.

A group of 60 primary and secondary English teachers took part in eight weeks of teacher training and trainer training delivered locally in Yueyang. During this initial training period, 40 of these teachers were selected to attend a four-week, face-to-face *Language & Cultural Awareness* course in the UK, before returning to cascade their knowledge in-country. The project concluded with a period of monitoring and evaluation by NILE trainers in China.

In a programme of various courses which has been successfully running for over 13 years, the Comunidad de Madrid regularly invite primary and secondary teachers to take part in a number of intensive training courses in CLIL, Language Improvement & Methodology, Literacy and Literature in ELT with NILE.

The longer 12-week CLIL programme focused on the needs of CLIL teachers across language, methodology, materials and assessment, with an option for teachers to take part in a school placement of teacher assistantship. Participants were assigned to primary and secondary schools in the Norwich area where they observed and assisted classes, worked

alongside local teachers, and immersed themselves in school life for 3–5 days. At the end of the course, participants returned to NILE's campus in Norwich to share their experiences and learn how they could use their new knowledge to develop their own teaching practices.



Language teaching methodology

Russia

-  Location: in-country training in Russia and online

Featuring a blend of face-to-face and online training, this project began with a one-week introduction and familiarisation programme in Russia to introduce the NILE Online course platform and explore approaches to communicative language teaching.

Following this initial face-to-face training, participants from Russian secondary schools took part in an online course for 12 weeks which combined language development and activity reflection work – through Macmillan English Campus – with methodology activities on the NILE Online platform.

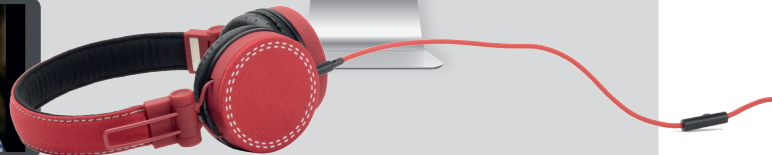
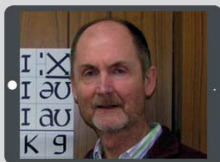
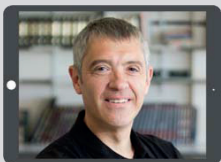
