## Banksy in the Big Apple

No sooner had Banksy announced his 'residency on the streets of New York' entitled Better Out Than In, than the first of two pieces he created were labelled graffiti. The first piece appeared in the Chinatown district of Manhattan, and shows two boys - one bending over and another one standing on his back, pointing to a sign on the wall which, provocatively, declares graffiti to be a crime. Alongside the two figures, a phone number

was painted on the wall, which constitutes a type of audio guide. The recorded message says: "Hello, and welcome to lower Manhattan. Before you, you will see a 'spray art' by the artist Banksy. Or maybe not; it's probably been painted over by now". This seems to be typical of Banksy's work. And the funny thing is that the piece was indeed painted over a day after it appeared.

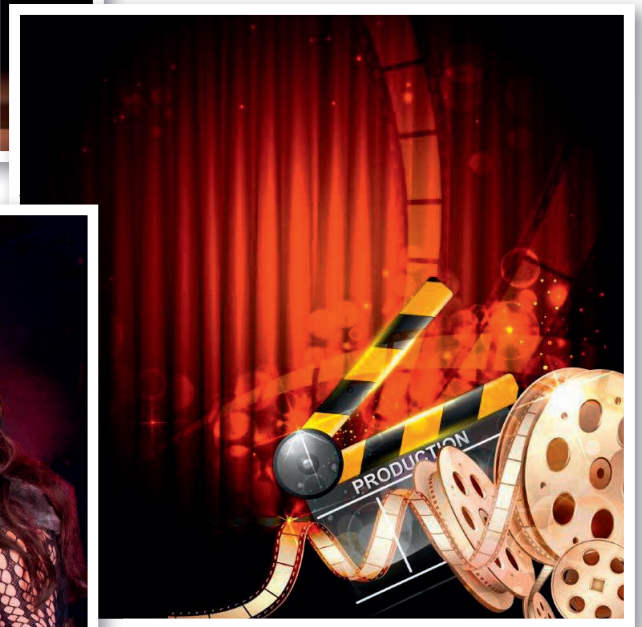
