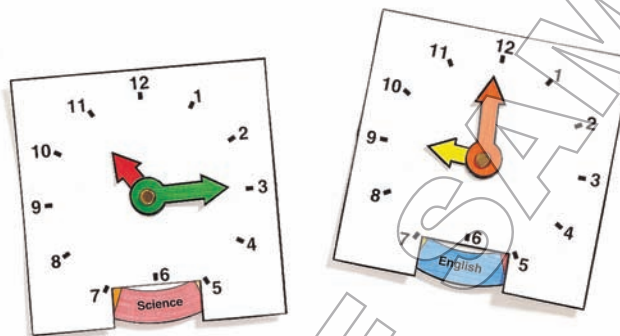

It's time to go home. It's time for tea!





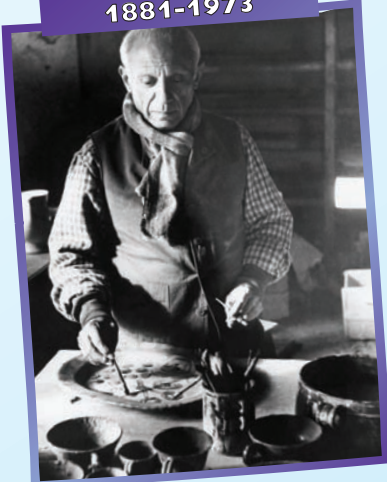
