



Study these rules for changing singular nouns (book) to plural nouns (books).

Add -s to most nouns name/names friend/friends

Add -es to nouns ending in s, sh, ss, z, x or ch box/boxes class/classes

Add -es to most nouns ending in -o hero/hero**es** tomato/tomato**es**

For nouns ending in consonant + y, change y to -ies hobby/hobbies family/families

For nouns ending in -f or -fe, change f(e) to -ves half/halves wife/wives
