

It's important to eat a good diet because it makes us healthy. A good diet has the correct quantities of sugars, proteins and fats. Sugars and fats give us energy. Proteins help us grow. The correct quantities of vitamins and minerals are also important.

Fruit and vegetables are part of a good diet. It's healthy to have 5 portions a day of fruit and vegetables. A portion is about 80 grams, which is about one cup. One medium carrot is a portion, one cup of spinach is a portion, and one cup of peas is a portion. It's important to eat different vegetables and fruit.
