



The Tiger Street Club meet in a shed in Ben's garden. The children listen to music and play games. One day ...

- Ellie: Look at this. It's a new magazine called *Tiger Team*.
- Ben: Let's write for it.
- Nasim: Great idea!
- **Clare:** But we can't. We haven't got a computer.

Comprehension questions

What is Tiger Team? (a new magazine)What do the children want to do? (write for the magazine)Have the children got a computer? (No, they haven't.)





- Ben: Hey! Look at Mrs Jones's house. Who's that man?
- **Clare:** Perhaps he's a window cleaner.
- Ellie: Or perhaps he's a thief!
- Nasim: Let's go and find out.

Comprehension questions

Who do the children see? (a man)

Where is the man? (in Mrs Jones's house/in the window)



Story card 3



The children run to Mrs Jones's house.

- **Clare:** Look, the window is open.
- **Nasim:** The man isn't on the ladder.
- Ellie: He's in the house!
- Ben: Oh no!

Comprehension questions

Is the window closed? (No, it isn't.)

Where is the man: on the ladder or in the house? (in the house)





The thief runs away.

- Ellie: Look! He's got Mrs Jones's laptop.
- Ben: He is a thief!
- Mrs Jones: Stop, thief!
- **Nasim:** Give the laptop back.

Comprehension questions

What has the man got? (Mrs Jones's taptop)

Is he a thief? (Yes, he is.)

Is the man a window cleaner? (No, he isn't.)

Who is the man? (a thief)





The thief falls over and drops the laptop.

Clare: Ha ha! Look. A banana. That's lucky!

Comprehension question

What stops the thief? (a banana)





Ellie: Look! It's a policeman.

Nasim: We can take Mrs Jones her laptop now.

Ben: Great! Come on.

Comprehension questions

Who takes the thief? (a policeman) What can the children take? (Mrs Jones's laptop)





Ellie: Look! We've got your laptop, Mrs Jones.

Nasim: Here you are!

Mrs Jones: Oh thank you, children.

Comprehension questions

What do the children do with the laptop? (They give it to Mrs Jones.)

Is Mrs Jones happy? (Yes, she is.)





A few days later ...

Mrs Jones: Here's a present for your club. It's my old computer. You can use it now.

Nasim: Wow! A computer!


Clare: Now we can write for the *Tiger Team Magazine*.

Ellie: Thank you, Mrs Jones. You're very kind.

Comprehension questions

What present does Mrs Jones give the children? (her old computer)

What can the children do now? (They can write for the Tiger Team Magazine.)





One day the Hare sees the Tortoise on the way to school,


Hare: Look at the Tortoise! He's got short legs and a heavy shell. He's very slow.

Comprehension questions

Has the Tortoise got a heavy shell? (yes/Yes, he has.)

Has he got long legs? (no/He's got short legs.)

Is he slow or fast? (slow/He is slow.)





Hare: I've got long legs and I'm very fast. Look at me, Tortoise! Bye.

Tortoise: I don't mind. I get there in the end.

Comprehension questions

Has the Hare got short legs? (no/He's got long legs.)

Is he fast? (yes/Yes, he is.)

Is the Tortoise worried? (no/No, he isn't./He doesn't mind.)





Hare:	Ah, here's the Tortoise at last! He's very slow and I'm very fast.
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- **Tortoise:** Well, let's have a race and see who the winner is.
- Hare: Ha ha ha! A race? With you?
- Animals: Oh no! Don't be silly, Tortoise.

Comprehension questions

Is the Hare happy? (yes/Yes, he is.) Does the Tortoise want a race? (yes/Yes, he does.) Is the Frog worried? (yes/Yes, he is.)






The Hare and the Tortoise get ready to start the race.

Mouse: One ... two ... three ... go!

Comprehension question

Do the Tortoise and the Hare have a race? (yes/Yes, they do.)





The Hare runs very fast.

Hare: Ha ha! Look at the Tortoise. I've got time to check my emails and play a game.

Comprehension questions

Is the Tortoise slow? (yes/Yes, he is.) Is the Hare fast? (yes/Yes, he is.) What has the Hare got? (a tablet) What does he want to do? (check emails, play a game)





The Hare sits under a tree. The Tortoise walks by. He's very slow, but he doesn't stop.

Hare: Go ... now ... yes! Again. Yes. Brilliant!

Tortoise: Ha ha! Look at the Hare with his computer game. This is my chance.

Comprehension questions

Does the Hare play a computer game? (yes/Yes, he does.)

Has the Tortoise got a chance to win? (yes/Yes, he has.)





The Tortoise walks and walks. The computer game ends. The Hare stands up.

Hare: Oh no! Look at the Tortoise. Quick! I want to win the race.

Comprehension questions

Is the Hare happy? (no/No, he isn't./He's worried.) Does he want to win the race? (yes/Yes, he does.)





The Hare tries to catch the Tortoise, but it's too late.

- Mouse: Hurray!
- Frog: Well done, Tortoise!
- Badger: You're the winner.
- **Tortoise:** Now I've got the time to check my emails and play a computer game, too.

Comprehension questions

Who is the winner? (the Tortoise)

Has the Tortoise got some free time now? (yes/Yes, he has.)

What does he want to do? (check emails, play a computer game)
