



- Jack:** Look, Daisy. Look, Grace. This is my room.
- Daisy:** Wow!
- Grace:** It's amazing!
- Jack:** Let's play with my rocket.
- Daisy:** Grace, stop! Look! Jack, is this your rucksack?
- Jack:** No.
- Daisy:** Oh!
- Grace:** It's a magic rucksack!

Comprehension questions

- What is magical? (*rucksack*)
- What toy has Jack got? (*a rocket*)
- What colour is the train? (*It's red and blue.*)





Daisy: The rucksack is a ... The rucksack is a ...

Children: The rucksack is a squirrel!

Sam: Hello, I'm Sam.

Children: Nice to meet you, Sam!

Comprehension questions

- What animal is Sam? (*a squirrel*)
- What's the squirrel's name? (*Sam*)





Children: Wow!

Jack: Daisy, Grace, look at my rocket now. It's big!

Children: Come on! Let's play.

Comprehension questions

- Is the rocket big or small? (*big*)
- Who is in the rocket? (*Jack, Daisy, Grace and Sam*)





Jack: Whoa! Look at me! I'm a pilot.

Sam: Mmm. An acorn.

Daisy: Look out, Sam!

Sam: Whoah! Whoops!

Children: Uh-oh!

Rocket: 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 ...

Comprehension questions

- Who says 'Mmm. An acorn'? (*Sam*)
- What does the rocket say? (5, 4, 3, 2, 1 ...)





Daisy: Wow, look at the planet. It's green and blue.

Jack: And look at the stars. Amazing!

Grace: Hello, planet! Hello, stars!

Comprehension questions

- What can the children see? (*a planet*)





Mum: Daisy, Grace, time to go home.

Grace: It's nice to have a new friend.

Jack: Bye, Grace. Bye, Daisy.

Grace and Daisy: Bye, Jack.

Children: Bye, Sam.

Comprehension questions

- Who goes home? (*Grace and Daisy*)

What's in your classroom?

Story card 1

Grace: Oh no! Where's my ruler? Can I have a ruler please, Jack?

Jack: Yes. Look, Grace! My ruler is big.

Comprehension questions

- What school object hasn't Grace got? (*a ruler*)
- Who is she asking for the ruler? (*Jack*)
- Is Jack's ruler big or small? (*big*)

Story card 2

Daisy: The ruler isn't big. We're small!

Grace: Look, Jack! Look, Daisy! It's Sam. Hello!

Sam: Hello!

Comprehension questions

- Are the children big or small? (*small*)
- Who says 'Hello' to the children? (*Sam*)

Story card 3

Grace: Look! It's my sharpener.

Daisy: And here's your rubber, Grace.

Grace: But I'm on the chair. Help!

Jack: I know! Let's put the ruler on the sharpener.

Comprehension questions

- What school objects can the children see? (*a sharpener and a rubber*)
- What does Jack want to put on the sharpener? (*a ruler*)

Story card 4

Daisy: It's a seesaw.

Sam: It's a trampoline. This is fun!

Jack: Be careful! Oh no!

Comprehension questions

- Who's having fun? (*Sam*)

Story card 5

Jack: Are you OK, Daisy?

Daisy: Yes, I'm fine.

Grace: Hello! I'm here. I'm on the chair.

Comprehension questions

- Is Daisy fine? (yes)
- Where's Grace? (*on the chair*)

Story card 6

Sam: Let's help Grace together! 1, 2, 3 ... Up!

Jack: Come on, Sam! Oh no! It's no good.

Comprehension questions

- Who's trying to help Grace? (*Sam, Jack and Daisy*)

Story card 7

Jack: Where's my ruler?

Daisy: It's here.

Jack: Let's put the ruler on the pencil case.

All: 1, 2, 3 ... Up!

Grace: I can see the ruler.

Comprehension questions

- What school object is Jack looking for? (*a ruler*)
- Where does Jack want to put the ruler? (*on the pencil case*)

Story card 8

Daisy: Are you OK, Grace?

Grace: Yes, I'm fine. Thank you, Jack. Thank you, Daisy.
Thank you, Sam.

Sam: Let's play again!

Comprehension questions

- Is Grace fine? (yes)

Story card 1

Daisy: Happy birthday, Jack.

Grace: We've got a present for you. It's in the rucksack.

Jack: Oh. Balls for juggling! Amazing! Thank you.

Comprehension questions

- Whose birthday is it? (*Jack's*)
- Who's got a present for Jack? (*Grace and Daisy*)
- Where is the present? (*in the rucksack*)

How are families different?

Story card 2

Daisy: Look!

Jack: It's a real circus.

Grace: And Sam's here.

Sam: Happy birthday, Jack.

Jack: Thank you, Sam. Who's this?

Sam: This is my little sister, Poppy.

Jack: Hello, Poppy. How are you?

Poppy: I'm excited.

Comprehension questions

- Where are the children? (*in a circus*)
- Who is Poppy? (*Sam's little sister*)
- Is Poppy excited? (*yes*)

Story card 3

Poppy: Come on, Sam! Let's go and play.

Sam: Poppy! Poppy!

Jack: Poppy, come back!

Sam: Oh no! Where's my sister?

Comprehension questions

- Whose tail is it? (*Poppy's*)
- Is Sam excited? (*no*)

Story card 4

Jack: Is this your little sister, Sam?

Sam: No, it isn't. This is my big sister. This is Penny.

Penny: Hello. This is a great party!

Comprehension questions

- Is this Sam's little sister? (*no*)
- Who's Penny? (*Sam's big sister*)

Story card 5

- Daisy:** Is this your little sister, Sam?
- Sam:** No, it isn't. This is my brother, Simon.
- Simon:** Hello.

Comprehension questions

- Is this Sam's little sister? (*no*)
- Who's Simon? (*Sam's brother*)

How are families different?

Story card 6

Sam: I'm sad. Where's my sister?

Simon: I'm sad, too.

Penny: And me, too. Let's tell Mum.

Comprehension questions

- Is Sam excited? (*no*)
- Is Simon sad? (*yes*)
- And how is Penny? (*She's sad.*)

How are families different?

Story card 7

Sam: Mum, I'm sad. Where's my sister? Where's Poppy?

Mum: Don't be sad, Sam. Poppy is here.

Grace: I can see her.

All: Where?

Comprehension questions

- Who's this? (*Sam's mum*)
- Is Mum sad? (*no*)
- Who can see Poppy? (*Grace*)

Story card 8

Poppy: Hello. What a fantastic party!

Sam: Come on, let's play!

Poppy: Yippee!

Comprehension questions

- Is Poppy happy? (yes)
- Is Sam happy? (yes)
