Task summary:

- Write a **description of a person**. Write about **an important person in your life**.
- This lesson is about **how to use apostrophes (')**. Use the **HOW TO** box on **page 28** to see when and how to use apostrophes (') when you write.
- Try to use **have got** from **page 23** and **whose?**, **possessive 's/s'** and **possessive pronouns** from **page 25** in your description.
- Try to use some new **words** from **page 131** in your answer too.
- Try to write about **50 words** for this task.

Model Answer

Words in **bold** are new vocabulary from this unit. Use new words from page 131 in your answer.

Say who your person is - family or a friend? Say how old he/she is. Say what his/her face is like.

My sister Kate

My sister Kate is 14 years old and she's really funny. Kate's **hair** is long and black. Her **eyes** are big and blue.

Use an apostrophe with possessive 's or s' (*my brother's eyes, my two sisters' eyes*).

Describe his/her things. Say what he/she has got. Describe the things.

She's got a lot of **nice** things. She's got lots of **different** clothes. She's got lots of friends. They're **noisy** and **horrible**!

Use an apostrophe for a missing letter (*you are = you're*).

- ✓ Count the words in your description to see if you've got the right number.
- ✓ Use more than one adjective with *and* to describe something (*her eyes are big and blue*).
- ✓ Use three or more new words from **page 131** in your description.
