Task summary:

- This writing task is a description. Write a description of **your favourite room for a pen pal**.

- Use **grammar** from **Unit 2** in your description. Use the **present simple positive and prepositions of time** from **page 23** and the **present simple with adverbs of frequency** from **page 25**.

- Try to write about **60 words** for this task.

Model Answer

Use present simple with adverbs of frequency to say how often you do things in this room.
