5.1. ____

Heath Ledger was born in 1979 in Australia where he began his acting career on local television. After performing on a number of series in the 1990s, Ledger left his homeland to try his luck in the US, hoping for a brilliant career overseas. Unfortunately, Hollywood wouldn't give the young actor a chance and he received no roles.

5.2. ____

After the initial failures came his first unexpected successes. An Australian director auditioned him for the lead role in 'Tow Hands', which he got. He showed his great talent and secured himself a role in '10 Things I Hate about You'. Although the film was a major success, it gave Heath the image of a lover boy, which he desperately tried to get rid of.

5.3. ____

Ledger set out to fight his image of a 'pretty boy of little depth'. He accepted a number of roles, some of which were complete disasters, leaving him really disappointed. His first big breakthrough came in 2005, when he appeared in 'Brokeback Mountain' and his outstanding performance was recognised by the BAFTA and the Academy. He didn't win any awards, but certainly made his name.
